

COACHING POSITION AVAILABLE Head Coach - Women's Soccer (Part Time | Contract Position)

Champlain College Saint-Lambert is inviting applications for the position of Head Coach for its Women's Soccer Program. Champlain College Saint-Lambert has an enrollment of 3000 students and is a member of the Reseau Sport Étudiant de Québec (RSEQ), the Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) and competes in Division 1 of the RSEQ provincial level.

Reporting to the Coordinator of Athletics, the incumbent is responsible for providing a positive student-athlete experience within the framework of the Cavaliers program, which enshrines the values of education, leadership and respect. The Head Coach will be responsible for providing leadership in the planning and continued development of a well-established Intercollegiate Soccer Program. The duties will include, but are not limited to, the coaching, recruiting and assisting in the monitoring of the academic progress of student athletes. The Coach will be expected to accomplish these tasks while respecting the values of Fair Play in Sport and working in a multi-sport program in an educational institution.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Promote the ethical values of the Champlain Cavaliers athletics program and Champlain College Saint-Lambert. These values include:
 - o pursuing excellence through personal development and teamwork;
 - ethical and responsible behavior on the field and off;
 - o adherence to the spirit of rules as well as to their letter; leadership and strength of character;
 - respect for one's opponents, acceptance of victory with humility and acknowledgment of defeat with grace.
- Ability to foster an inclusive and positive environment for our student-athletes.
- Promote and support student-athlete academic success through the Cavalier Academic Success Program.
- Develop a recruiting program which will identify prospective student-athletes for Champlain College.
- Coordinate team fundraising activities in conjunction with the athletics department.
- Conducting of try-outs and selection of team members.
- Preparing and directing practice sessions. (3-4/week in season | 1-2/week out of season)
- Development of an annual training program.
- Supervision of the team in competition. (August November)
- Attend league coaches' meetings and other league functions as required.
- Contribute to the personal, academic and athletic development of the student-athletes.
- Liaise with the athletics department regarding all aspects of the program.

Qualifications:

- Éducateur de soccer provincial (ESP) Canadian Soccer Association Licence B (Part 1) or equivalent.
- Minimum of three years coaching in a post-secondary institution, elite soccer environment or similar experience.
- Strong communicational, motivational and organizational skills.
- Capacity to interact in a positive manner with student athletes.
- Ability to work in a team.
- Thorough knowledge of soccer in Quebec.
- Strong verbal communication skills in English and French.
